Update from the Doctors Surgery

Everyone here at Jubilee Medical Group is trying their best to deal with your query or request and provide the best possible service to all of our patients. We want to be able to provide the most appropriate care for each individual patient and this may be in the form of face-to-face consultation, telephone consultation or video consultation.

We are still open and here for you. We are continuing to provide services as we have been doing throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. We are prioritising delivering of care and services based on clinical needs. Neither Kent House or New Ash Green Surgery are closing.

GP receptionists are in the front line and see both the best and the worst of us all. They work incredibly hard to help patients navigate the system but may not be able to offer you exactly what you want at all times. Please be patient and courteous, they want to find the best solution as much as you do. We have a zero-tolerance policy and will not tolerate abusive behaviour to our staff.

There has been a huge increase in demand for appointments and general queries. This is inevitable given that so many of our patients have been managing health issues themselves rather than contacting their doctor over the last year and many hospital procedures and appointments have been necessarily delayed. As confidence in general is returning, many patients are now quite rightly contacting us to address those issues. COVID-related work has been inevitable but taken up much staff time. Our staff have adapted to new ways of working, many have been isolating at times and some have been



shielding. In addition, we have suffered higher than normal levels of staff sickness and some staff loss due to the stress of the past year.

The practice are currently looking at getting a queue system for the telephones so patients know where they are in the queue so they can decide whether to continue or ring another time.

Finally, patients are encouraged to use eConsult as an alternative way to receive advice. eConsult is a way to contact your own GP practice online. It is easy to use and will give your Doctors all the information they need to triage and make sure every patient gets the care they need.



CCTV Network - Help tackle crime and fly-tipping!

Ash-cum-Ridley Parish Council needs homeowners and businesses in New Ash Green, Ash, Hodsoll Street and Ridley with CCTV, doorbell cameras, dash-cams and even wildlife cameras to come forward and form a Parishwide 'CCTV Network' to assist the Police in tackling crime and flytipping within the parish.

Once we have the information of where cameras are located, the locations will be stored on a secure database by the Parish Council. If there is an incident of crime, antisocial behaviour or fly-tipping reported, the owners of the cameras in the immediate vicinity will be contacted and given a time frame and any other relevant information, so

that they can check their footage for evidence. You may then be asked to burn the footage off for the Police or Sevenoaks District Council's Community Safety Unit.

The data is being stored in compliance with Data Protection guidelines and will not be shared with any organisations other than the Police and Community Safety Unit. Some have reported concerns believing New Ash Green Village Association will be able to access the data, the Parish Council can confirm the VA will have no access.

We hope by establishing this network, we can help to speed up the evidence-gathering process and aid in



securing prosecutions for incidents that occur in the parish.

The Green Man Fire

The Parish Council was devastated to hear of the recent tragic fire at The Green Man in Hodsoll Street.

We welcomed a couple of residents from Hodsoll Street at our June 2021 meeting, they highlighted issues regarding the mapping and maintenance of fire hydrants. The Parish Council will be raising these concerns with Kent Fire and Rescue Service whom are responsible for these.

The Parish Council are also keen to support any efforts to see the site continue it's use as a public house. An application to register the site as an 'Asset of Community Value' is currently being prepared.

If we are successful in securing this registration, it will mean that the landowner; the Stonegate Group would be obliged to notify Sevenoaks District Council if they wished to sell the site. This triggers an initial sixweek moratorium period for any community organisation to decide if they want to be considered as a potential bidder for the site. If that is the case, a six-month moratorium



period begins which enables the community organisation to develop its proposal and raise the money required to buy the asset.

Two of our councillors; Frank Cottee and Shaun Fishenden recently met to explore the option of community ownership for The Green Man. They are currently obtaining advice from national organisations and other community-owned pubs about the viability of pursuing this option for The Green Man.
